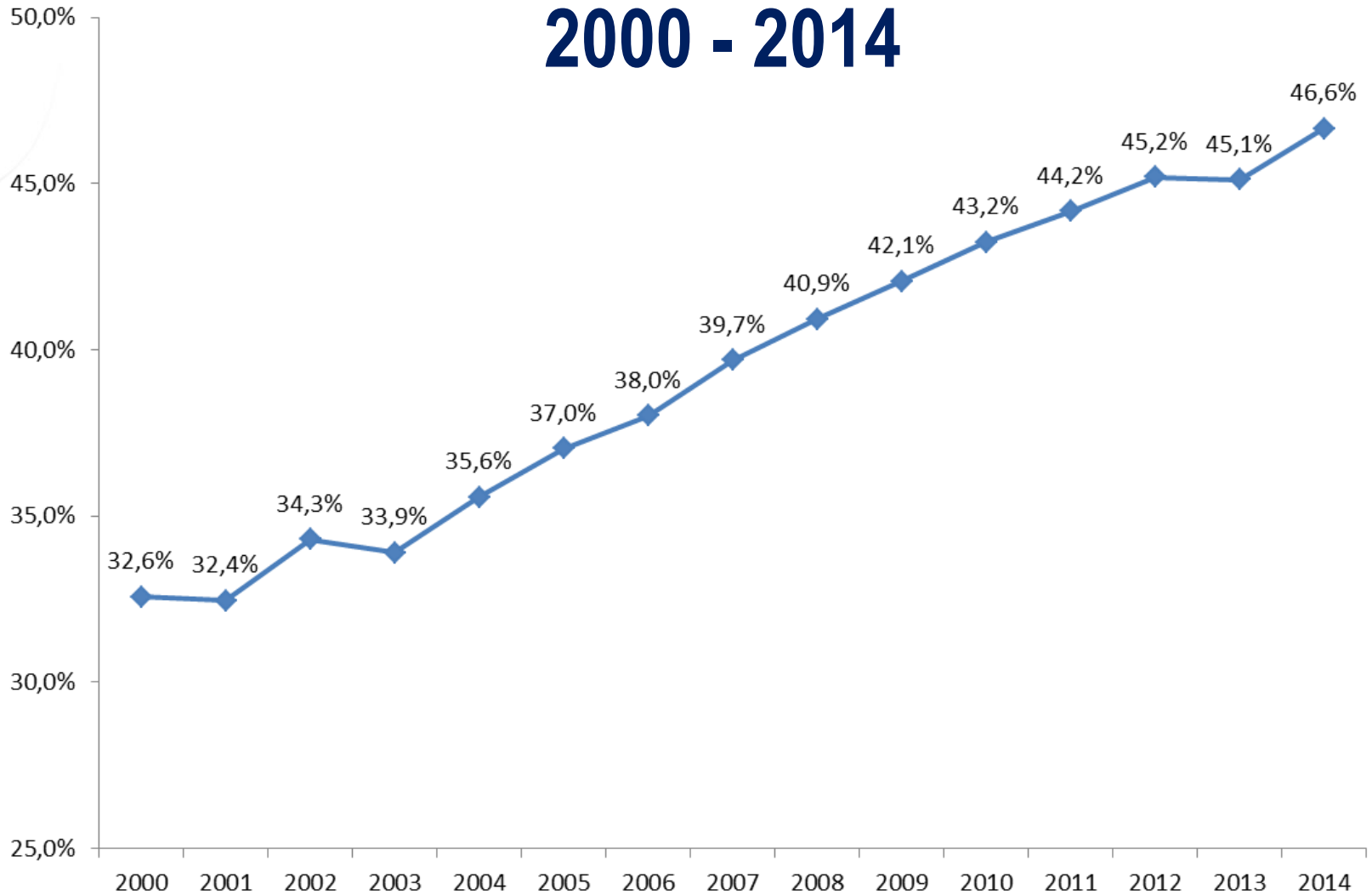

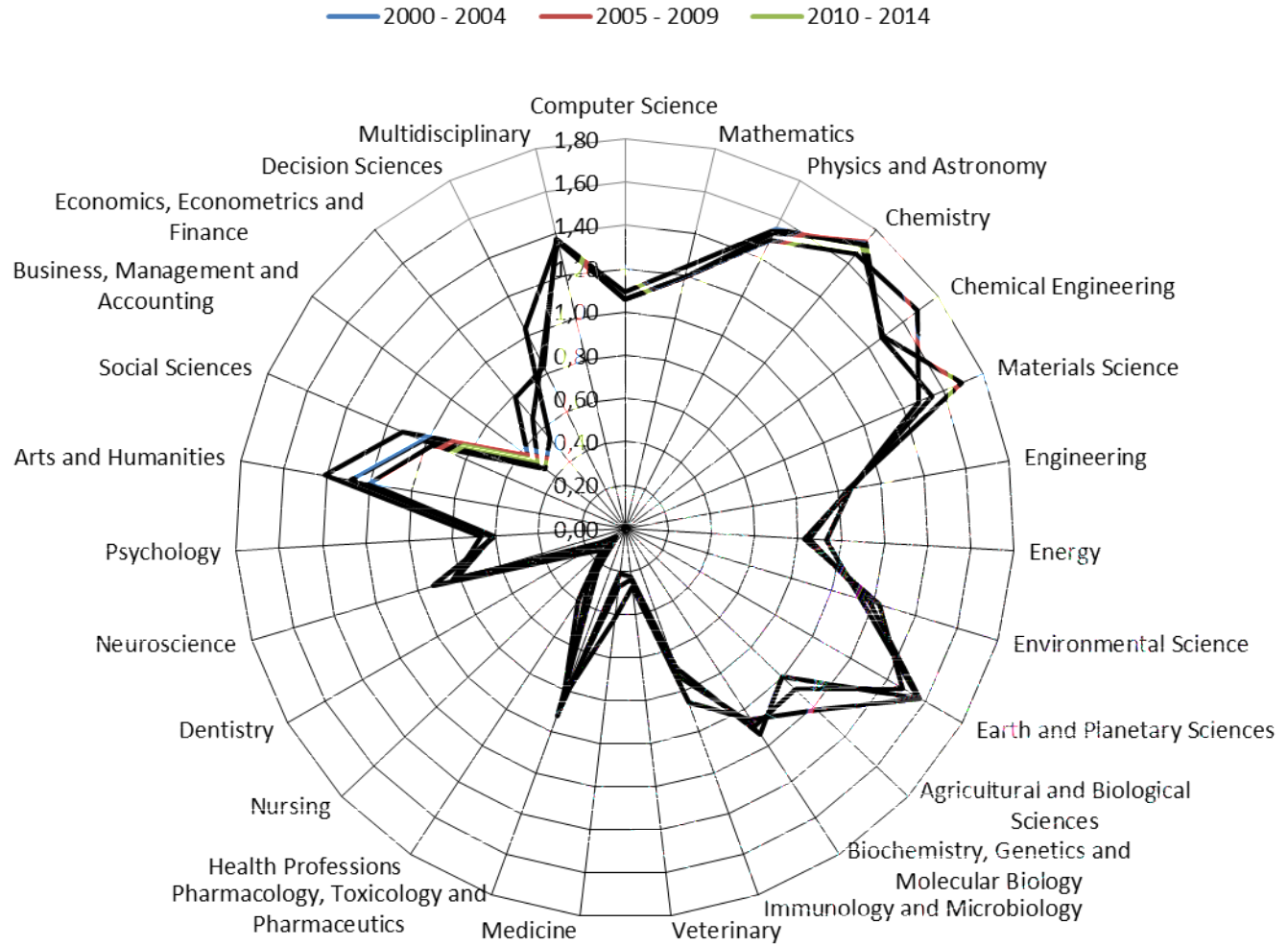
CNRS and Max Planck Society have a similar relative amount of collaborations

RELATIVE ACTIVITY INDEX

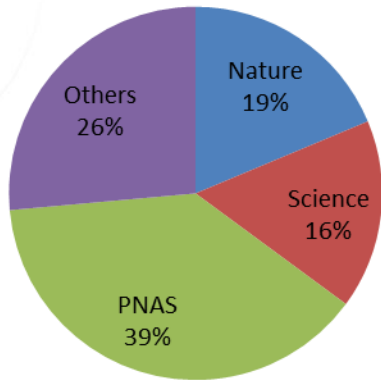

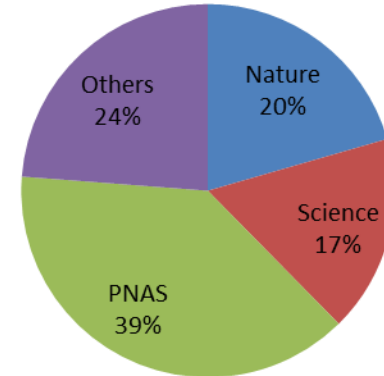
PUBLICATIONS IN MULTIDISCIPLINARY JOURNALS, 2000 - 2014



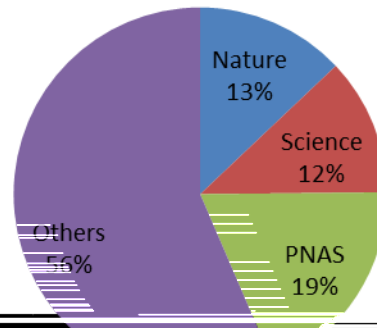

Involved in the law “Pour une République numérique” (for a digital Republic)

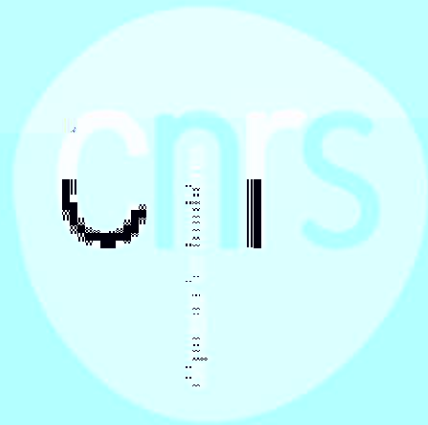
